

COOKIES POLICY

1. Use of Cookies

A cookie consists of information sent by a web server to a web browser and stored by the browser. The information is then sent back to the server each time the browser requests a page, enabling the server to identify and track the browser.

2. Types of Cookies We Use

We use both session cookies and persistent cookies. Session cookies are deleted when you close your browser. Persistent cookies remain on your device until deleted or expired.

3. Purpose of Cookies

Cookies are used to track website usage, recognize returning visitors, understand user preferences, analyze behaviour, improve content and services, and enhance user experience.

4. Third-Party Cookies

We may work with third-party providers such as Google Analytics, which use cookies to analyze website usage. These cookies generate statistical data about visitor interactions, helping us improve our services. Such providers are responsible for their own cookies and data handling practices.

5. Consent

By using our website, you consent to the use of cookies as described in this policy. Where required, a cookie notice will be displayed to obtain your consent.

6. Managing Cookies

Most web browsers allow control over cookies. You can block or delete cookies through your browser settings. However, disabling cookies may affect the functionality of certain parts of the website.
